

PAIN MANAGEMENT: We take pain relief very seriously and employ preventative pain management strategies using local anesthetics, anti-inflammatory drugs, and other analgesic medications for all surgical procedures, wounds, dental extractions and arthritis related issues.

ULTRASOUND: We perform advanced abdominal and heart ultrasounds at our office in order to rapidly diagnose and help treat many conditions. These scans are performed and interpreted both at our hospital and can also be electronically sent to specialists for further interpretation.

PROGRESSIVE DENTAL CARE: Periodontal disease is the number one health problem in cats and dogs over three years old. Dental disease can lead to serious liver, kidney, and heart disease. We provide an extensive dental care program and use the safest anesthesia along with advanced monitoring, digital dental xrays, fluoride treatment, ultrasonic scaling and polishing. Preventative dental care may add years to your pets' lives while improving their quality of life.

CANINE REHABILITATION: Our program uses a variety of therapeutic exercises and modalities to improve function and promote healing. Our goal is to improve the condition of our patients through the use of our heated underwater treadmill, cold laser, ultrasound therapy, electrical stimulation, manual exercises and other therapies. Our patients

include pets with the following issues: **post operative orthopedics, spinal cord injuries, arthritic pets, obese pets, canine athletes, working dogs and many more.

WEIGHT LOSS PROGRAM: Fit pets live a longer and healthier life! Our Purina Project Pet Slimdown certified weight loss coach will design a plan to get your pet to a healthy weight. Our coach will calculate the caloric intake necessary for weight loss and set and monitor goals. Exercise programs may include workouts on our underwater treadmill and routines to practice at home.

LASER THERAPY: We offer cold laser therapy. This non-invasive tool helps reduce pain and inflammation and increases the speed of healing from wounds and surgery.

DIGITAL RADIOGRAPHY: Digital radiography provides high quality radiographs to aid in the diagnosis of many issues. Images are captured quickly and with lower doses of radiation. We also have the capability to electronically send copies to our peers for further review.

HOLISTIC MEDICAL CARE: Holistic therapies are those that take the whole patient into account when prescribing, and that encourage the body to call on its own recuperative powers to heal. Holistic medicine is individualized for each patient and treatment may include acupuncture, chiropractic manipulation and herbal medicine.

ONCOLOGY: Through advanced ultrasound, x-rays and biopsy techniques we diagnose many types of cancer. We also offer a variety of treatment options including surgery, chemotherapy to help extend your pet's quality of life.
